The aim of the Company is to identify our responsibility by alerting staff to the risks, however small, in our own business and within our supply chain and stakeholders in general

This policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business activities and demonstrates that we implement and enforce effective systems to ensure that there is no modern day slavery within our own business or in any part of our supply chain.

This policy takes into account and supports the policies, procedures and work instructions documented within our Integrated Management System that is compliant with ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 20121:2017

The Company will achieve the aims of this initiative and mitigate the risk in the following ways:-

- Stringent vetting of our supply chain
- Internal audit of our practices for checking all our employees are paid at least the minimum wage and have the right to work
- Encourage the reporting of concerns and protect the whistle blowers
- The Company will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in modern day slavery or trafficking
- We have zero tolerance to modern day slavery and human trafficking and therefore expect our supply chain and contractors to comply with these same values.

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern day slavery and human trafficking our Directors, Managers and staff have been all briefed and trained on the subject

This policy is in accordance with the Modern Day Slavery Act 2015
